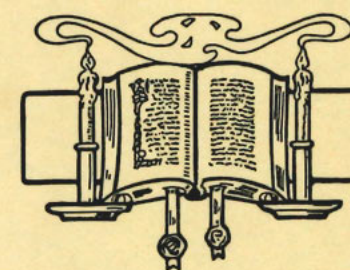

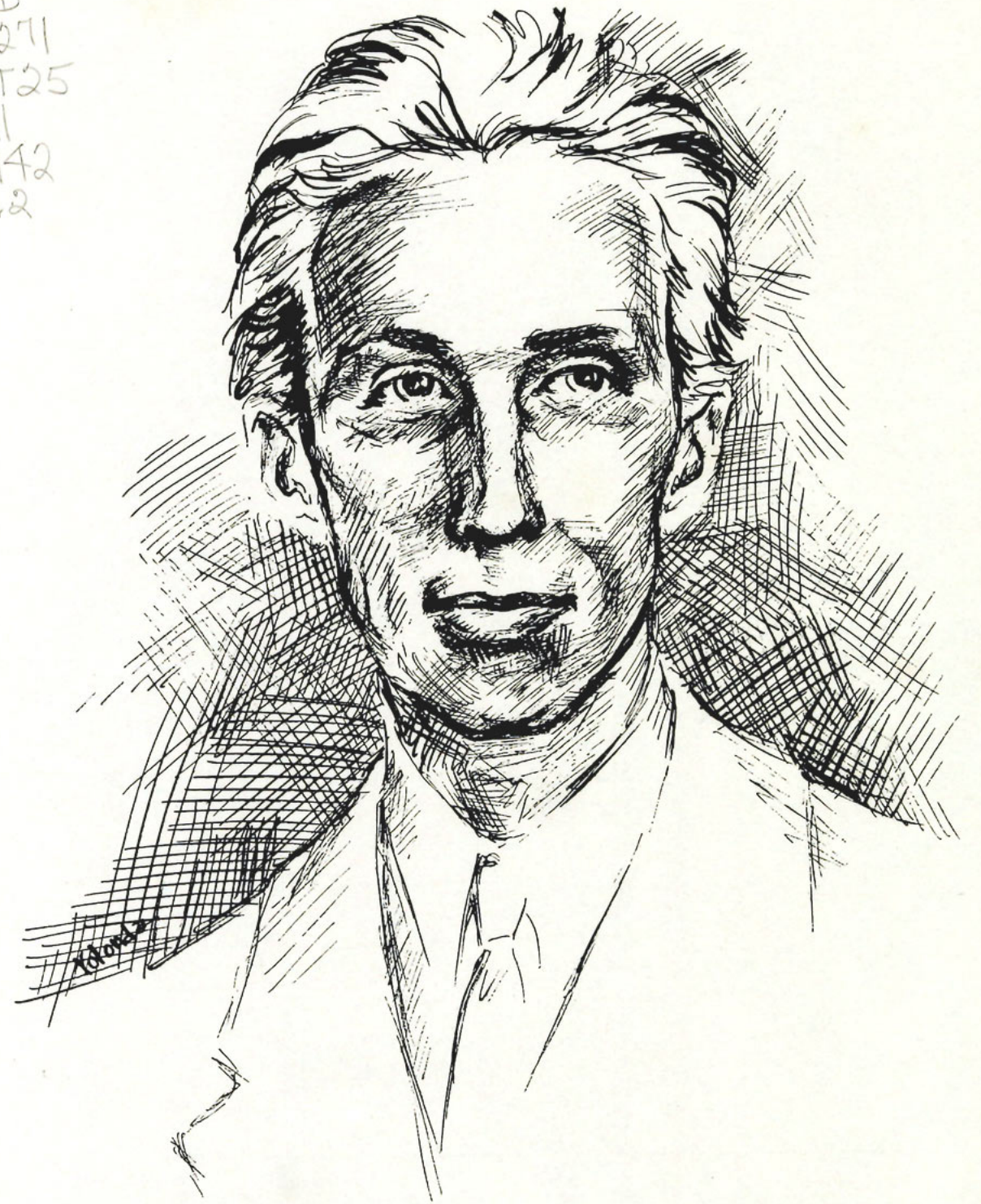
## Foreword
