University of Tampa Gets In The Swim

Much attention has been focused recently on a large hole in the ground at the University of Tampa. The hole measures 60 x 75 feet, is lined with special plaster, and is filled with sparkling turquoise water-and is, of course, the new AAU-NCAA regulation swimming pool, dedicated in appropriate style October 30.

This handsome new facility is serving not only the University community, but also the larger Tampa community, thus strengthening the "town-gown" relationship UT has always nurtured.

As part of the University athletic program, the pool primarily serves recreational purposes. It has already become a favorite spot for students on warm afternoons: it also serves as the classroom for a SCUBA course. Future plans include intramural swimming and diving competition, and eventually an intercollegiate swim

The pool is also becoming a focal point for the Tampa community. By special agreement between the University and the Greater Tampa Swimming Association (GTSA), the association uses the pool for its training program. In return, GTSA is providing UT with an aquatics director any college athletic program would covet: Craig McConnell. McConnell, an All-American swimmer with an impressive dossier, supervises the maintenance, management and programming of the new pool.

All this healthy activity and competition, the friendly cooperation and good feelings were made possible by a group of people who were generous with their time. money and talent. The recent dedication ceremony served in part to honor these people

Financial resources for the \$100,000 pool were supplied by the past two graduating classes, and by R. S. Lang of Lang Aquatech Pools, pool builder. Construction of the pool was supervised by Nicholas Dennis, UT's Director of Physical Plant. Many long hours of construction were put in by University maintenance personnel, especially Luis Rio. And thanks to Harry A. MacEwen, architect, and Mrs. Charles West, landscape artist, the pool is both functional and aesthetic

Attending the dedication were trustees, administrators, faculty, staff, students and other UT friends. The impressive ceremony included an aqua show featuring Kathy Hoyne, student body president, who dove in and swam to the center to cut the traditional ribbon. Following the presentation of appreciatory plaques and a swimming and diving exhibition, a christening toast of champagne summed up the festive mood of this important occasi
