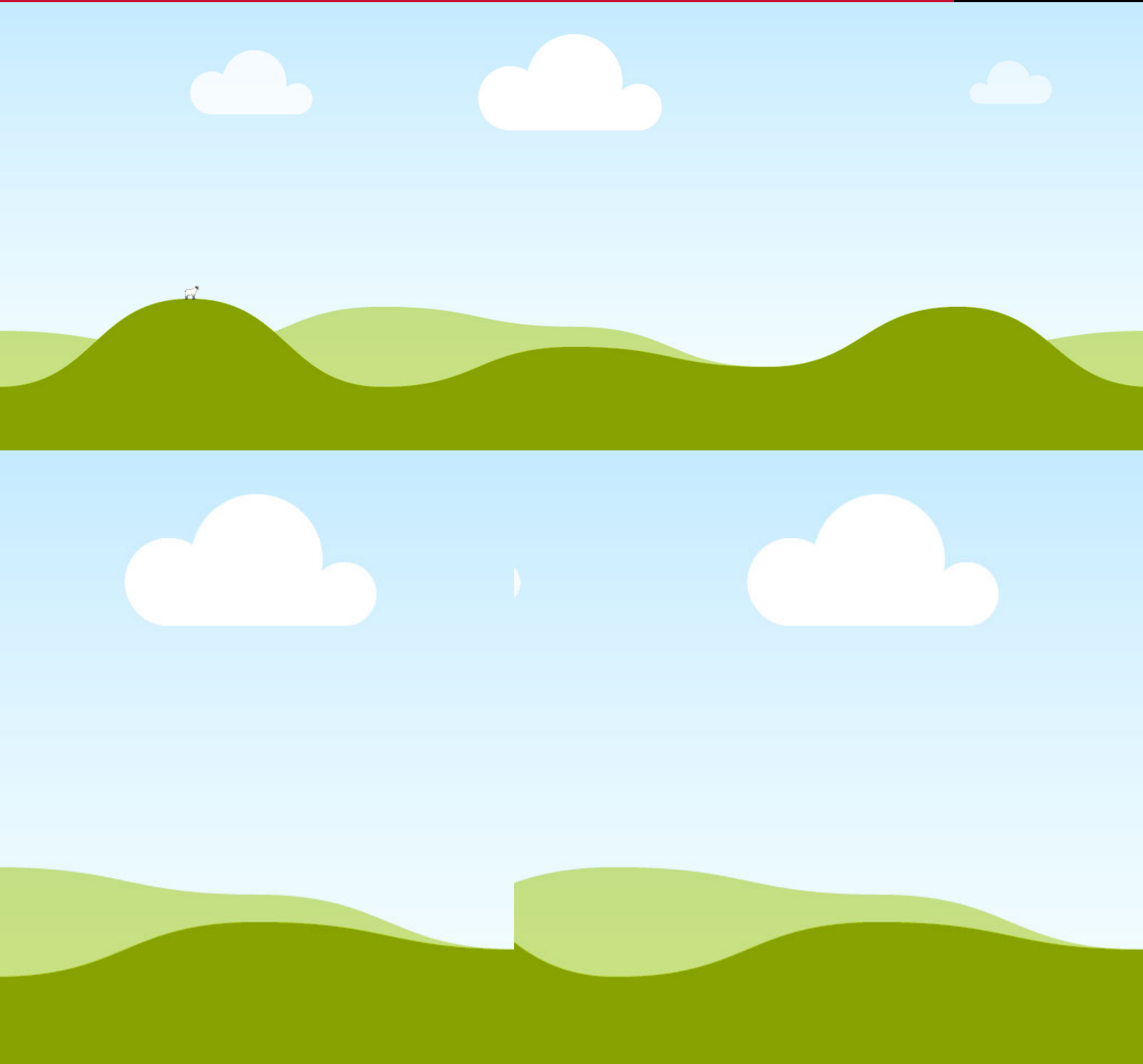

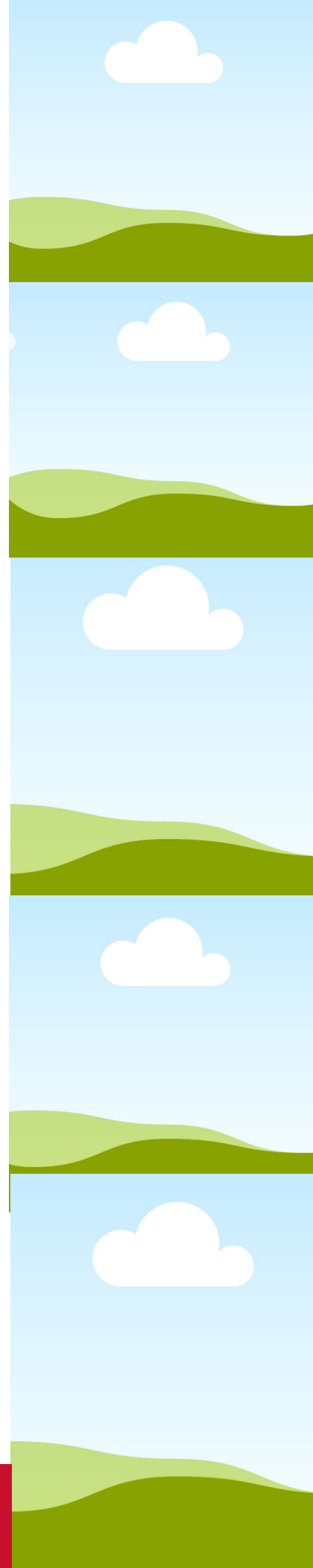

WHY STUDY ABROAD?



96% of study abroad alumni participants responded that their study abroad experiences made a difference in their career plan.



86% of study abroad alumni participants responded that their study abroad experiences helped them adapt to diverse workplace environments.



85% of study abroad alumni participants responded that studying abroad was the most meaningful experience of their undergraduate education.



58% of study abroad alumni participants responded that studying abroad helped develop skills that contributed towards receiving their first job.



65% of study abroad alumni participants responded that studying abroad contributed to the importance they place on finding a career they find interesting.



70% of study abroad alumni participants responded that studying abroad contributed to the importance placed on having personal fulfillment in their career.

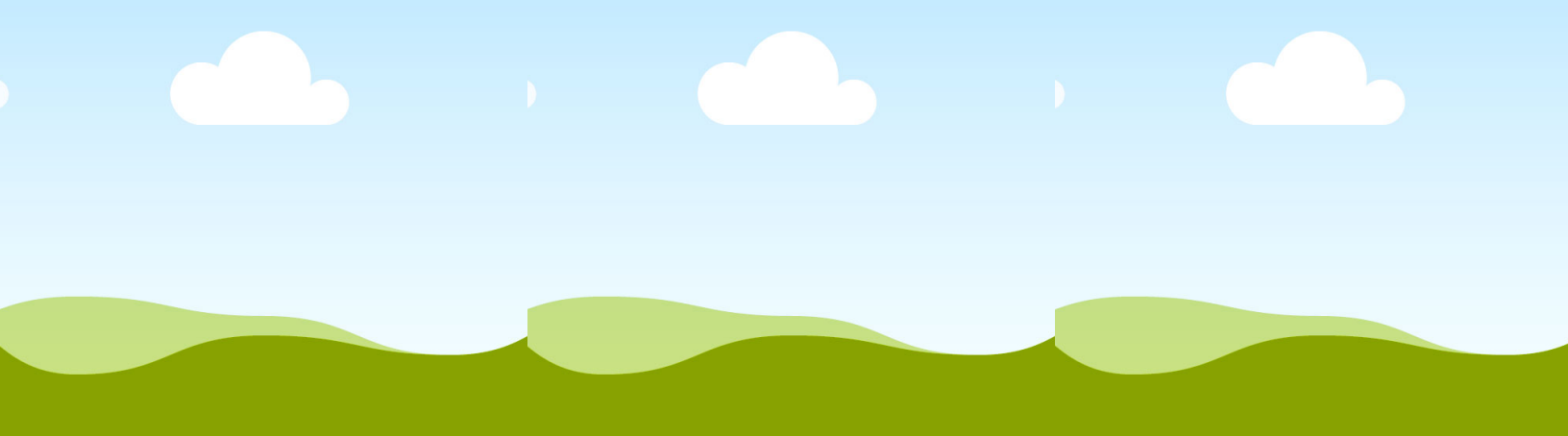

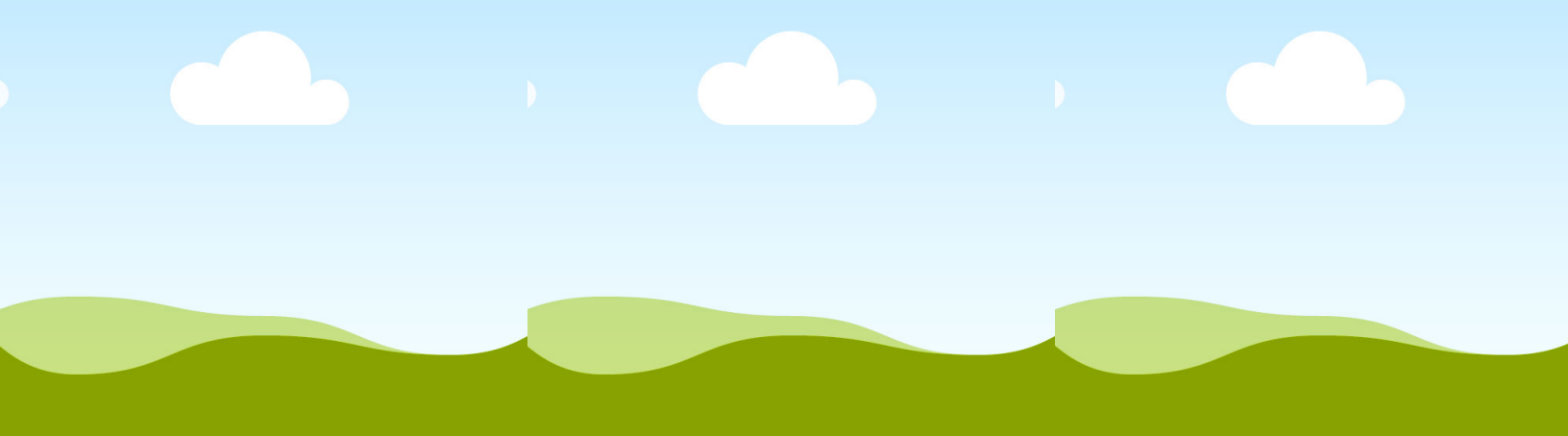

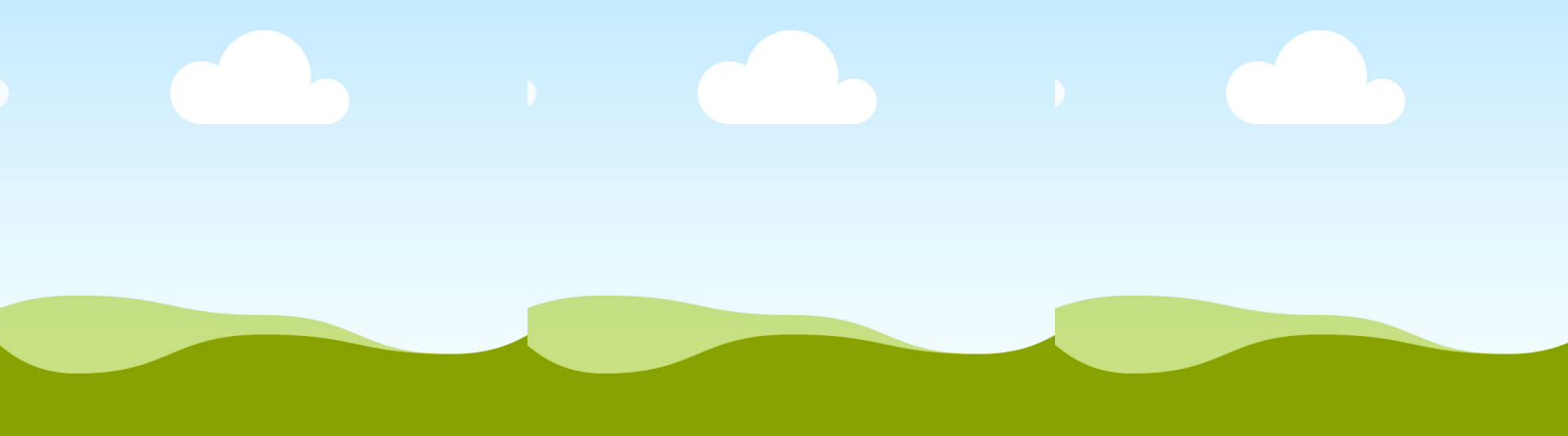
