

PHASE III: ACADEMIC AND STUDENT LIFE ADVANCES

From President Ronald L. Vaughn

he 1997-98 year was again pivotal as we move toward our long-term goals. There are many signs of success and progress evident across the University. In the first three years of my administration we were concentrating on building enrollment, operating in the black, increasing endowment and improving the facilities. Those initiatives encompassed in Phases I and II are still on-going, but our efforts are now shifting to enriching academic and the quality of student life. Here are a few examples of what we have accomplished in the past year.

Enrollment Progress

When classes start this month we expect to set another all-time record for total student enrollment, replicating our record-breaking accomplishments in Fall 1997. In the past four years we have grown from 2380 students to an expected Fall 1998 enrollment of about 3,000 students. We are making good progress toward our goal of about 3,600.

Although competition for students, particularly the better students who can afford a private education, is becoming even more intense, we will take advantage of our enrollment strength to continue to enhance our student profile while keeping priorities of attracting a diverse mix of students and special talents in mind. We are being very selective in adding additional students toward the end of our recruitment period.

Despite the opening of the new "Tower" residence hall with an increased student capacity of about 160 students over Howell Hall, we exceeded our capacity by the time school started and were again using the Holiday Inn/ Ashley Plaza for temporary overflow housing. The increased desire for on-campus housing is partially due to the fact that more of our continuing students want to live on campus because of better value and student life options.

The quality of our incoming students also continues to improve. For the fourth straight year, the average grade point of incoming students was up, although we won't know the exact increase until data is gathered. However, the Fall 1997 average high school GPA was improved to 3.15 over the GPA of 3.03 for the Fall 1996 entering class. Also, a larger percentage of our entering students now have GPA's of

3.5-4.0 or 3.0-3.49. Finally, the admissions standards for our Honors Program has been raised to a minimum GPA of 3.5 on a 4.0 scale:

Student Retention Efforts

A number of initiatives were developed this





past year to further improve student retention:

- •The Gateways II program was piloted and began this fall as part of a year-long Freshman Experience aimed at immersing the new student in a variety of practical learning situations aimed at building confidence and knowledge.
- •The "Partners" customer service training program was initiated for all on-campus student workers, with 225 student workers participating this last fall.
- •We also focused on streamlining registration processes and improving advising support. Because of these efforts, we improved pre-registration results in our highest Fall 1998 pre-registration of continuing students this past spring.
- •Development of a new Degree Audit Program is underway to facilitate faculty advising and tracking of progress toward degree requirements. A new user-friendly report design was tested this summer for several academic programs.

Student Life and Other Campus Improvements

We expanded many student organizations and started about a dozen new

ones. There are now 90 officially-registered student organizations that had about 1100 activities and events during the 30 weeks of our two semesters. This doesn't count a few hundred athletic events offered by our 14 men's and women's NCAA athletic teams, art shows, or music, dance, drama, or special guest speaker programs. During this past year, campus vibrancy has clearly reached a new high.

•The use of the McNiff Fitness Center grew by 23%. More aerobic programs were added, the outdoor basketball and volleyball courts became increasingly popular, and student involvement in UT intramural and recreation opportunities was increased.

•Our athletic teams continued to do well with much positive recognition for the University while we maintained our commitment to helping our athletes graduate. Our baseball team won its third National Championship (see story, page 11). We also added women's soccer as a NCAA sport officially beginning this fall.

•Student counseling services were moved to the Health Center to provide a more holistic approach to student health care. This summer the Health Center was moved to its own building just west of the new residence hall.

 Career Services completed a thorough review of all its programs and services and implemented several improvements, most notably the installation of JobTrak. This on-line resource allows students and alumni to post their resumes and have access to jobs nationwide. Placement results of last year's graduating class showed 22% immediately went to graduate schools of various types and 100% of those seeking jobs were employed within six months while 90% were employed within three months. Also, 100% of UT's ROTC cadets were commissioned with highly preferred "active" assignments.

•Under the heading of student leadership, the PEACE volunteer program expanded by 40% in the number of agencies served (87 vs. 62) and the number of volunteer hours served (17,123 vs. 12,226) over the prior year. There were approximately 32 student organizations involved in community

service this past year. Volunteer service by the entire University community increased to about 40,000 hours of service to more than 100 agencies.

•The co-curricular transcript service grew to 334 students that now list their activities and honors while enrolled to be included as part of their transcript and placement credential portfolio.

Academic Improvements

•The Academic Center for Excellence


(ACE) assisted over 500 students with more than 9,200 hours of academic assistance this past year. The exceptionally high success rate of 99% was continued as almost all students who regularly used ACE received grades of A, B or C. This year, ACE will be expanded into the residence halls in order to increase services to students because tutoring space is at a premium.

•The library acquired LEXIS NEXUS, a popular full-text research database, and it has already proved to be a well-used resource. The library also just announced that satellite capabilities will be upgraded to include Ku-band signals to provide access to PBS Adult Learning Service programs.

• Planning continued in preparation for development of an expanded and refurbished "Library of the Future" for UT. We expect details on these plans to be announced during the next academic year.

•The UT tradition of awarding honorary degrees, dormant since 1987, was re-introduced at the May commencement with the awarding of a Doctor of Business and Humane Letters to Mr. John H. Sykes. A Doctor of Fine Arts degree will be awarded at the December commencement to Mr. Sam Gilliam, a noted American artist.

•The Music and Nursing programs were recommended for and awarded accreditation. Our H. B. Plant Museum is also going through extensive

work as part of a national accreditation effort.

• A British partner was added to our exchange system with the signing of an agreement with the University of Westminster. International training aids were prepared for faculty and staff to facilitate better international travel and study experiences.

• Development of a new M.S. degree program in Physical Therapy was undertaken with a Fall 2000 start date anticipated. Development of a new Athletic Trainer/Sports Medicine program was also begun along with the accreditation process for the program.

• Another U.S. Dept. of Education grant was received (this one for Project E.A.G.L.E.) to enhance our continued emphasis on internationalization of the educational experience. We have also received preliminary word that we will receive another new international grant, effective this Fall.

•The number of full-time faculty positions was expanded, and outstanding new faculty members were added in both Fall 1997 as well as those recruited to start for Fall 1998. A Faculty Development program series offered such topics as technology applications, service learning, simulations, and the Freshman Experience.

• About 25 teaching excellence and innovation projects were funded during this past year. Classroom and tech-

nology enhancements were completed in several program areas with more underway for the science and Falk Theatre areas. •Academic task forces focused on Experiential Learning and Connected Learning. Recommended enhancements of the current educational experience are now being considered. The Honors Program and Saunders Writing Center

also continued to grow and develop.

Technology

A new technological era for the University was launched with \$2 million in expenditures (over several years) for a new fiber optic campus network and numerous computers. By October, all of UT's residence halls and most of the campus will be connected and wired for technology utilization. This high speed, broad bandwidth system provides internet, e-mail, intranet, and other on-line services to the University community. It is the only system of its kind, at least for a while, at a Florida college or university. We purchased about 400 new MAC and PC computers during the current year, added two more computer labs and upgraded most of the others.

Campus Facilities And Grounds Enhancements

- •Construction continued throughout the year on the new Residence Hall and Parking Deck. The five-story deck was opened this spring and provides 580 parking spaces. The new residence Tower provides a 9-story, 120,000square-foot facility for 385 students.
- •Howell Hall was demolished in July and the site will now be part of the dramatic new entrance to the University and includes a small parking lot for the new residence hall, "The Tower."
- •We continued efforts to improve campus security and our students' perception of their safety and security.
- The new entrance to the University at Crescent Place is approximately a \$500,000 project and will be completed this year.
- Plans were also underway for conversion of Mckay Auditorium into a state-of-the art John H. Sykes College of Business Building. When completed in about two years, the building will provide about 30,000 square feet of additional space in Plant Hall for the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences.

University Development, and Administrative Improvements

- •On September 11, 1997, we announced a \$10 million gift from John and Susan Sykes, the largest gift in the University's and Tampa Bay's history. The gift was formally announced in the December 1997 *Journal*.
- •For the third year in a row, we are again concluding the fiscal year "in the black."
- •We refinanced a University bond issue which saved about \$80,000 per year and \$1.6 million over the life of the issue.
- Last spring, we worked with The Chiselers to receive a State of Florida grant of over \$300,000 to begin restoration of the west veranda, the balustrade, and part of Plant Hall's foundation.



College of Business Awarded Grant

he U.S. Department of Education has awarded a two-year \$165,000 grant to The University of Tampa's College of Business. The funds will be paid out over two oneyear terms, beginning in September.

This grant brings the total from the USDE to \$485,000 since 1992. Combined with matching funds from the University's own resources, these grants have underpinned nearly \$1 million in support for programs in international business education.

The University will use the money to further internationalize existing business programs and to provide outreach programs and activities to benefit the Bay Area business community.

"The growing importance of international trade," said Hemant Rustogi,


project director, "has motivated us to explore new horizons in international education. This grant will help us realize UT's vision of being involved in a meaningful way in the world beyond our country's borders."

One approach is through technology-driven education. The University will acquire distance-learning and video-conferencing equipment. With that technology, according to Rustogi, UT will be able to greatly expand its services to the international business community by offering seminars at various sites throughout the bay area and throughout the world from one central UT location.

The grant will also fund faculty exchanges with business schools in Argentina, Brazil, Chile, Mexico, and Canada. In addition, it will fund new scholarships and create internship/ field experience opportunities for College of Business students. In conjunction with offering a Latin American certification program to business professionals, a portion of the grant will go toward funding three new Latin American seminars: Negotiations; Joint Ventures; and Import/Export Issues.

Local international business people will benefit from a lecture series featuring Latin American speakers.

"These initiatives are consistent with our vision 2005," said Rustogi, "to create a campus that provides global programs and activities that enhance international cultural understanding."





Nursing Masters Program Accredited

ith some trepidation UT's Department of Nursing launched its graduate program in January of 1994 to award Master of Science in Nursing degrees (MSN). Unfortunately the trepidation was well founded. The Tampa Bay medical

community began downsizing that year. Instead of nurses holding tuition reimburs ement to ursement employers, many were holding pink slips and looking for jobs.

But in spite of the bleak employment outlook that year, one thing remained clear: the long term trend in nursing was for more formal training.

"With the practice of medicine growing more complicated both from technology and from managed care," says Nancy Ross, director of the program, "nurses who want to advance in their careers will need more education."

Knowing that the demand for post graduate nursing education was strong, and confident that UT could fulfill the demand with a quality program, Ross and the School of Nursing persevered through the first year of the program and stuck boldly to the plan. Part of the plan was to offer an MSN to family nurse practitioners and in September of 1995 students began classes for that program.

Nurse practitioners are trained to be primary caregivers and in most states can prescribe medicine just like doctors. In many states they can hang out a shingle and operate independently, but in Florida, they still must maintain an affiliation with a supervising doctor. The practitioner track has proved the far more popular program, with candidates outnumbering those in the administrative track by five to one.

Early determination paid off. The MSN program has been highly successful. It currently has an enrollment of about 120 students and has graduated 65 Masters of Nursing.

In February the National League for Nursing (NLN) arrived on campus for a rigorous accredita-

tion visit. Officials examined the credentials of the faculty, the quality of communication between faculty and students, the administration, and the governance of the University as a whole.

"It was a long and exhaustive process," says Ross. In June the NLN notified the University that the graduate nursing program met the high standards of excellence for national certification.

For graduates of the MSN program, the recognition of high standards was thrilling, but came as no surprise.

"When you attach Dr. Ross's name, it means quality. I never saw accreditation as a problem," said Maurice Brazil, the Chief Flight Nurse of Bayflight, the emergency helicopter service of Bayfront Medical in St. Petersburg. Bayflight serves six counties and has been featured numerous times on national TV's Rescue 911. Brazil earned his MSN as a family nursing practitioner in December of '97 and was not at all concerned that the program was not yet accredited.

Brazil graduated with honors. "In the nursing profession education is everything. Now I can turn some heads in my industry. Since finishing, I have contributed to four professional journals and been invited to participate in an international conference."

He also teaches at St. Petersburg Junior College where they "really increased my pay." In addition he's working in primary care at a clinic several days a month.

Sandra Ffrench-Rose came to UT in 1993 after receiving her nursing certification in Jamaica and completed her BSN and her MSN at UT while working full time. Not only did the program accommodate her working requirements, "the faculty catered to my cultural needs, fostered and mentored me. It was a very positive experience."

Ffrench-Rose is joining the Love and Care Clinic in Tampa, a clinic dedicated to serving the needy.

"It's what I want to do," she says.
"My talents will be better served and these patients need me."

In the fall, she enters the University of South Florida as a Ph.D. candidate.

According to Dr. Ross, the nursing shortage of a few years ago is giving way to a shortage of educated nurses. By the year 2000 this shortage could be acute.

"Nurses today are expected to be critical thinkers and effective decision makers. They must be able to negotiate from a position of knowledge and confidence and to write with judgment. The entry level requirement is fast becoming a baccalaureate degree," said Ross.

SALUTE TO ALUMNI Where we they wow?


Dear UT Science Faculty,

It has been nine years since the spring that I graduated from UT. There are times that it seems much longer, with all the things that have gone on in my life since then. There are also times it seems like it wasn't that long ago that I was fretting over test material in Dr. Punzo's cell biology class, cutting on a variety of animals in Dr. Schlueter's Comparative Biology, or holed away in the basement performing experiments for Dr. Snell.

For the past nine years I have continued my education at Duke University. The weekend of May 17th, I will finally have my M.D. and Ph.D. degrees conferred and be done with my education. Well, that is not entirely true. I will begin my residency training in Pediatrics at the Duke Hospital for Children in June, which is a three-year process

My intentions for writing you at this time are two-fold. First, as an alumnus of the Science Wing, I feel compelled to share this news with you, as it has been a long time coming. Second, and most importantly, I wanted to express my gratitude to the UT faculty for preparing me so well for the training I have just completed.

I arrived at Duke in the summer of 1989 surrounded by students from Stanford, Harvard, Duke, Johns Hopkins,




Yale, Washington University and Dartmouth, to name a few. Not only was I the first person from UT to attend Duke Medical School, I was the first to even apply. Duke, then and now, was ranked as one of the top five hospitals in the nation. The environment was impressive and intimidating. I quickly found that the education that I got at UT was equal to, if not superior to many of my colleagues. In the first block of classes, I received Honors (top 10%) in Biochemistry (thank you Dr. Winkler), and was one question away from honors in genetics (thank you Dr. Punzo). The next block, I received honors in Cell Biology (thank you again, Dr. Punzo). I am sure that the study habits developed while preparing for similar courses at UT, and the information learned from them contributed a great deal to this early success.

Probably the most important aspect of my UT experience was the environment. Most of my medical classmates were schooled through at least half of their education by graduate assistants who may not have known much more than the students they were lecturing. Their inexperience would also suggest that they were most likely not very good teachers yet. I can count on one hand the number of professors in medical school that were comparable in quality to all the UT professors.

In addition, I could approach any of the UT faculty to discuss class material, opportunities in science, or anything else from fishing to baseball with ease. For me, the open, supportive atmosphere was very conducive to creativity and getting the most out of my education.

UT Science has a rich history of sending people to prestigious, competitive graduate and professional schools around the country. In addition, many recent graduates and colleagues of mine have returned to the honored profession of education, no doubt influenced by the same professors as me. The UT Science faculty should be proud of the people it has prepared so well to enter the competitive world. The current UT students should know that history proves that UT graduates who take advantage of the resources available to them have the tools necessary to achieve the most impressive of goals, in the most competitive of places.



Dr. Jan Dargel, dean of the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences, has accepted a position as dean of Arts and Sciences at the College of Marin in the San Francisco area and will be leaving UT in November. President Ronald Vaughn said he will soon appoint an interim dean and quickly commence a national search to select a successor.

Vaughn appointed Dargel as interim dean in May 1995 and named her permanent dean one year later.



UT Retires Perlow's Uniform

Mickey Perlow, the only UT business professor to get away with wearing shorts to class, retired in May after 18 years of teaching accounting. Many of the estimated 4,000 students he taught over the years will remember his wry humor and casual dress which immediately put students at ease. One of the most popular professors at the University, Perlow never had to worry about his student evaluations. Characteristically, he had the last laugh by wearing a blue "power suit" to his retirement party where he was recognized for his teaching excellence and showered with gag gifts.

Kings of A Cappella

Rockapella, the perennial kings of the a cappella scene and for five years the house band for "Where in the World is Carmen Sandiego?" were scheduled to appear at UT's Falk Theater on Friday, Sept. 18. Rockapella's appearance was a homecoming for lead singer Scott Leonard. A former tennis star at UT, Leonard graduated in 1987 with a degree in music. He is the group's primary songwriter and wrote nine of the 12 tunes on the group's latest al-

bum, *Rockapella*, and performed the lion's share of production duties.

A Connection for Every Pillow

Under an extensive technology project, UT now has an Internet connection for every student room in the University. The plan to wire every residence hall was started last spring with a target completion date of August.

New Faculty

Since last fall, the University has hired or replaced approximately 21 new full time faculty who started teaching in September or will arrive in the spring semester, 10 in the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences and 7 in the College of Business. Three searches are underway for the Masters in Physical Therapy program.

New Residence Hall Full

The new residence hall, called "The Tower" is filled to capacity with 385 fresh-

men and upperclassmen. Some students who had been living off campus are moving back because of the increasing amenities available on campus. For example, "The Tower" boasts a living room and break room on every floor. On the ground floor are a game room, computer lab, study room, lounge area and huge laundry room. The various floors are color coordinated and decorated with prints of famous artists. All rooms are either singles or doubles, and the furniture is solid wood with a cherry veneer.

Record Class Pushes Population to 3,000

The University expected to seat another record freshman class in late August which was expected to push the population to 3,000 or more students. Although the actual number of new freshmen would not be known until mid September, early indications were that it would exceed 600 students, which surpasses last year's record class of 488 by 25%. About 90% of freshmen will live on campus compared to 80% last year. Despite the growth in students, UT's historically low student-teacher ratio of 16 to 1 is expected to remain stable. Class sizes average approximately 22. Under the master plan, the University population will be allowed to gradually rise to about 3,600 full and part time students, including graduate and other special programs.

Student Leaders

Under the heading of student leadership, the PEACE volunteer program expanded by 40% in the number of agencies served (87 vs. 62) and the number of volunteer hours served (17,123 vs. 12,226) over the prior year. Volunteer service by the entire University community increased to about 35,000 hours of service to over 100 agencies.

UT Spartans — NCAA Champions Third National Title this Decade

ere's an idea: Let's adopt Montgomery, Ala. as our sister city. The University of Tampa Baseball Team already calls it "our home away from home."

For the last three consecutive years and six times in the 1990s, the Spartans have finished their season there. Why? Because Montgomery is the home of the NCAA II National Baseball Championship Series, where UT is a regular guest and this season sat at the head of the table.

On May 30, Tampa capped a perfect post-season (7-0) run by defeating top ranked Kennesaw State (Ga.) 6-1 in the televised national championship game. Junior hurler Mike Valdes responded to being named National Pitcher-of-the-Year and first-team All-America earlier in the week by tossing a four-

hitter for Tampa's seventh consecutive post-season "complete game" by a starter.

The "complete game" streak was among many outstanding achievements which made Coach Terry Rupp's third time at Montgomery a charm.

Ranked No. 2 nationally and fresh from a second straight Sunshine State Conference championship, the Spartans raced through the NCAA South Region and National Championship Series undefeated.

In the South Regional, held for the first time at St. Petersburg's Al Lang Field, the Spartans defeated SSC rivals Florida Southern 4-2 and Barry twice, 8-2 and 13-0. At Montgomery's Paterson Field, UT drew the toughest bracket but was not fazed in beating No. 5 Central Missouri State 9-5, and third-

ranked West Georgia 5-1 and 10-0 before advancing to the title game.

Kennesaw State entered the championship game ranked No. 1 with a Div. II record 61 victories against just four losses.

The Spartans were not intimidated as Valdes took a perfect game into the fifth inning before the Owls scored their lone run, a solo shot by Pat McPhee. In all, KSU mustered only four hits off Valdes (15-1), who struck out four enroute to his nation's best 15th victory.


Sophomore shortstop Ronnie Merrill, who combined with junior second baseman Louis Martinez and first baseman Miguel Menendez to set a tournament record with six double plays in the 5-1 West Georgia win, was named Tournament MVP after hitting .529 in the series (9-for-17) with nine RBI. In four games, UT's infield recorded a tourney high 13 double plays.

Pitching and defense were magnificent for the Spartans, who were scored on in only three of 36 possible innings. Central Missouri, entering the tourney with a national best .394 batting average, scored all five of its runs in one inning when Valdes surrendered three homers, but he remained to complete the 9-5 win. West Georgia got a solo home run in game two for its only score against Rick Burton and was blanked by Eric Busch in game three before Valdes completed the sweep allowing just the single homer against Kennesaw. While Burton finished the year 9-3, Busch, a transfer from USF who was injured much of the season, posted back-to-back post-season shutouts against Barry in the South Region title game and West Georgia.

Although Rupp and Assistant Head Coach/Pitching Coach Nelson North did not go to the bullpen, they were ready as the Spartans clearly boasted the deepest staff of the tournament. Among the eight quality relievers who didn't see action were Greg Watson, who was named second-team all-SSC as a reliever, and John Hipp, who was second-team all-region after setting a school record for appearances (32).

Consider Rupp's own achievements as head coach. Since being named to his first head coaching position in the summer of '95, Rupp has, in all three seasons as a collegiate head coach, guided his Spartan teams to the national finals tournament, placing fifth, third and now first nationally.

Twice, his teams have posted a school record 46 victories. His initial response at the Paterson Field post-season press conference was, "I think we're going to be better next year. These players you're interviewing, they're all coming back."

The Year in Review

Honors

A Productive Year: Tampa won four Sunshine State Conference championships in 1997-98 and tied for 22nd nationally in the Sears Directors Cup Trophy Race, which tallies points from all NCAA championship appearances for the school year. The SSC titles were won by women's volleyball, men's soccer, men's basketball and baseball. Scoring at the NCAAs were volleyball, soccer, men's and women's swimming, and baseball.

Spartan student/athletes captured their share of individual honors, topped by baseball pitcher Mike Valdes who was first-team all-conference, all-region and All-American, earning Pitcher-ofthe-Year honors in each category, which led to him being named the Sunshine State Conference Male-Athlete-of-the-Year, Tampa's first since 1989-90.

First-team soccer All-American, SSC Player-of-the-Year and school career scoring leader Henrik Nebrelius (Ystad, Sweden) was voted Sunshine State Conference Male-Scholar-Athlete-ofthe-Year and received a \$1,000 postgraduate scholarship from Publix Super Market Charities.

Volleyball players Melissa Serio (Venice), a first-team All-America, and Hilary Epling (Roseville, Cal.), a second-team All-America, were Tampa's respective nominees for the female awards. Tamari Thompson (St. Petersburg Lakewood) was voted men's basketball Player-of-the-Year.

Baseball

Tampa placed five players on the NCAA Baseball all-Tournament Team, including senior centerfielder Erik Mirza (Tampa Chamberlain), juniors pitcher Mike Valdes (Brandon Bloomingdale), designated hitter Mike King (Gorham, Me.), second baseman Louis Martinez (Tampa Hillsborough) and sophomore shortstop Ronnie Merrill (Tampa Jesuit), who was named MVP.



The Spartans graduated four starters: First-team All-America catcher Angel Diaz (Lakeland), first-team all-conference centerfielder Erik Mirza, secondteam all-region starting pitcher Rick Burton (Gainesville), 30-9 career record, and leftfielder E. J. White (Tampa Hillsborough), .321/5 HR/33 RBI.

Coach Terry Rupp was named South Region Coach-of-the-Year.

Best Baseball Surprise was freshman Matt Smith (Tampa Bloomingdale), who got off to a disappointing start, sat out several games, then put together a string of 15 games in the second half when he hit eight homers. He completed the season with 10 home runs and raised his average from below .200 in March to .288. Due to an injury to second baseman Adrian Merkey prior to opening at Montgomery, the infield was shifted around with Smith playing third base for the first time all season during the final four games where he made four assists and no errors.

Elitest Player: Junior rightfielder Eric Sims (Tampa Jesuit) made his fourth NCAA Elite Eight appearance in three years, including two with baseball and two as the starting keeper on UT's

soccer team. the

Mike Valdes, First-Team All-America and National Pitcher-of-the-Year, SSC Male Athlete-of-the-Year.

It was almost a perfect six, but he missed the '97 baseball finals with an injury and the '98 soccer team missed Elite Eight with a 1-0 overtime loss in the field of 16.

Hope for JV players: Mike King is a true product of Tampa's junior varsity program, which suits 25 mostly walkon players each year. King started the '97 season as a "JV," but impressed coaches with his speed and appeared in five varsity games as a pinch runner. This year, he played in 38 varsity games as both a leftfielder and designated hitter and led the regulars in hitting with a .393 average.

"There was a time early in the season when almost none of our veteran guys were hitting," said head coach Rupp. "We were looking for a leftfielder and Mike came from way down the bench to spark the whole team. Giving him a chance was one of the best decisions we made as a staff."

Speaking of the junior varsity, firstyear volunteer coach Barry Shone did an outstanding job in guiding the Spartans to a 9-13 record, including a firsttime win against HCC.

While the baseball team garnered the school its seventh overall NCAA Championship to highlight the school year, there were several other success stories.

Volleyball

Chris Catanach's volleyball team posted its best winning percentage in school history with a 31-2 record and was ranked No. 1 in the final regular season AVCA poll, earning a 12th NCAA Tournament bid in 14 years. Expectations were high that the Spartans could follow their '97 national runner-up finish with an NCAA title. UT shared an SSC co-championship with Barry posting an 11-1 mark as the national powers split their regular season series. In the South Region title game, they met head-to-head again with Barry winning and handing Tampa its only two losses of the season. In addition to Serio and Epling, Danielle Faggion was also named second-team All-America. Catanach was named conference coach-of-the-year.

Soccer

Keith Fulk's soccer team won its fourth straight SSC Championship and received its 12th straight NCAA Tourney bid, but lost 1-0 in overtime to Lynn, placing sixth in the final poll. Henrik Nebrelius set four school records for goals in a season (31) and career (72) and points in a season (66) and career (163) to earn first-team all-conference, all-region and All-America while being named Conference Player-of-the-Year and Scholar-Athlete-of-the-Year. Senior Anders Paulsson (Sollentuna, Sweden) was also named first-team All-America.

Swimming

Swimming is definitely back at UT as Coach Ed Brennan's men's team placed fifth while the women were 17th at the NCAAs. The fifth place showing was Tampa's best since the men were third in 1985. Spartan swimmers set five school records while seven were named All-America at the national championships: Chad Sundermeyer, Jim Kiner, Tim Slamkowski, Bill Frye, Preston Bokos, Scott McLearn and Jennifer McLeod. Sundermeyer (St. Louis, Mo.) earned the AA ranking in three individual events and with three relay teams.

Basketball

Richard Schmidt's men's basketball team had great potential and played well through most of the conference season to win the regular season cham-

pionship for the first time since 1994. Sandwiched around the SSC slate was a slow start hampered by injuries and eligibility problems which were cleared up by January and a faltering finish at the SSC Tourney which led to an overall 16-11 record. Tamari Thompson was named Player-ofthe-Year after ranking high in five statistical

categories while Don Mallory (Indianapolis, Ind.) was voted first-team all-conference.

The women's basketball team, under Coach Tom Mosca, finished 12-15 with mid-season transfer Heather LeVan (King, N.C.) making an impact and earning second-team all-conference. An early season injury to center Chervara Smith (Ft. Myers) proved fatal to the Spartans' hope for a better result.

Softball

There's light at the end of the tunnel for Leslie Kanter's softball team, which posted its first winning season, since 1993, at 22-20. Shortstop Kelly McKendree (San Antonio, Fla.) earned first-team all-conference while Missy Agnitsch (Homosassa), Melissa Tapia (Tampa Seminole Presby.) and Dawn Wallace (Dunedin) were second-team. Agnitsch graduates with five career and two season school records.

Cross Country

Significant strides were made by Peter Brust's men's and women's cross country teams as each jumped from the bottom of the SSC in 1996 to third place in '97. Freshman Emily Saunders (St. Petersburg Lakewood) placed fourth to earn all-conference honors while Tom Vars (Tampa Robinson) was second-team all-SSC for the men.

Crew

Bill Dunlap's women's rowing team took second place in the four-team SSC Championship meet. Four boats qualified for the Southern Regional, including the varsity women's lightweight four, the men's novice lightweight four, the men's novice heavyweight four, and the women's novice heavyweight four. The men's novice lightweight four crew of Paul Trusik, Ron Caffrey, Tom Glass, Mike Roach and coxswain Bill Schaudt took gold in the qualifying Southern Intercollegiate Championship Regatta.

Golf

Rick Christie's men's golf team placed fifth at the SSC Tourney and 17th in the Southeast Regional. James Thompson (Chesire, England) was named a Golf Coaches Scholastic All-American. Marc Mitchell (Clearwater Countryside) was UT's top finisher at the SSC Tourney, placing 10th.

Tennis


Gregg Gruhl's women's tennis team was sixth at the SSC Tourney but placed its first all-conference performer in senior Katica Robertson (Liverpool, England), who posted a 14-6 record at No. 1 singles and became the Spartans' all-time victories leader. She set school records for singles wins in a season (14) and career (35) and doubles career wins (24). The Spartans were just 2-16 in dual matches, but defeated its first Div. I opponent, since 1992, Bethune-Cookman.

Taking Stock at Year-End . . . and Giving It

If she happens to be in the 31 percent tax bracket and claims the deduction on her itemized tax return, she could possibly save \$2,325 in taxes more than what she paid for the stock in the first place!

Historically, year-end is a popular time for making stock gifts. In fact, most stock gifts occur during the fourth quarter of the year. Many thoughtful donors review their stock portfolio and select those stocks which have appreciated the most and which have been held for more than a year.






