

## a message from the president

The qualitative advances made by your University during the 1972-73 academic year have been most noteworthy. These most favorable developments came as a result of dedication and support from the faculty, staff, trustees, students, alumni, parents and donors. Indeed, the University gains its enrichment, its strengths, its vitality, and its creativity from its many publics who are desirous of furthering progress towards our objective: The Uni-

versity of Tampa as a "Landmark of Learning."

One significant event of the year, the Inaugural Week, focused all our thinking on "The Private University in the 70's: Failure or Fulfillment." Each symposium, concert and lecture underscored the great destiny which lies ahead for private higher education for those institutions which responsibly identify the educational contribution they can make in the 1970's. During the week, the University of Tampa was rededicated to the goal of academic excellence. The assessment of institutional strengths and weaknesses was positive and encouraging. Those involved in the Inauguration, both as planners and as participants, discovered that the University of Tampa is, indeed, rapidly becoming a national "Landmark of Learning." The Inauguration Week also served to reassure us that your University is destined to succeed. The results of the academic year clearly show how the university community responded to the charge for fulfillment.

Significant national attention was focused on the University of Tampa throughout the year. In the fall, we learned that the Dana Foundation had granted us \$250,000 for the Charles A. Dana Professorship Program. This placed us in a select category with some 20 other universities. This is a matching grant and is to be used for faculty enrichment. Two Charles A. Dana Professors have been named. They are Dr. Curtis Gilgash, a University of Tampa Professor of Psychology, and Dr. Robert Henderson, an internationally known management teacher and consultant. Two other Dana professors will be named in the near future.

It is most significant to note that the Dana Grant was received in December and matched — by a single anonymous donor — in March. This is an impressive display of support for the University and its academic programs.

Faculty upgrading continued throughout the year. We are pleased to announce that our percentage of full time faculty members with earned doctoral degrees

has grown from approximately 40% in 1970 to approximate 60% in 1973. We will continue to place emphasis on this phase of our qualitative growth and development.

Another major project underway this year was the ten-year academic accreditation self-study. This study is required prior to the visitation by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools pursuant to reaccreditation of the University. Microscopically, each functional operational area has been systematically reviewed. Once again, there is every indication that our University is "on the move." We are confident that our accreditation will be renewed when the inspection team visits our campus next winter.

The Board of Trustees approved two graduate degree programs. This fall, the first students will enroll in the new Master in Business Administration Program. In January, we plan to offer courses leading to a Master in Education degree.

Dr. Robert Henderson, Charles A. Dana Professor of Management, will join the faculty in August and will, in addition to his teaching responsibilities, direct the MBA Program. We are actively recruiting our first class and urge you to announce this program to your friends and colleagues. These new programs provide an excellent opportunity for some of you to return to your alma mater for advanced studies. We hope to see many of you working towards your MBA or M.Ed. Please let us know if you desire additional information on either of these degrees.

This summer, the Trustees authorized the appointment of a committee to conduct a feasibility study of establishing a school of law. We have reason to believe that another law school may be needed in Florida. However, before reaching a final decision, we are awaiting the committee's findings and recommendations. If you have any reaction to this proposal, we solicit your written response. We will keep you posted on future academic program developments.

In September of 1974, we will institute a new academic calendar. We are changing from the present 4-1-4 and going to a 4-4-1. Our Intersession period will be transplanted from January to May. After careful consideration of the calendar, we know it will effect great savings in space utilization and physical plant maintenance. Further, it should assist in our effort to retain some of the students who currently are dropping out or transferring during the long winter break. Our Continuing Education programs will benefit greatly from this change since residence halls and classrooms will become available for long-term seminars and institutes. This should result in attracting more conferences and meetings in which the participants desire on-campus accommodations.

Financially speaking, as depicted and explained in other pages of this **Muezzin**, the University has again demonstrated its consistent pattern of sound fiscal management. The University managed, notwithstanding the adverse effects of the national inflationary spiral and an enrollment decline, to balance its operational budget. This has been accomplished without sacrificing quality.

For those of you who have not visited the campus recently, you are urged to see our newly renovated physical plant. We take great pride, as do all members of the University community, in the appearance of our campus. Both inside and outside our buildings, there is evidence of the dedication to excellence by our maintenance and custodial staffs.

Thanks to the generosity of Mrs. Maria Swed and the Chislers, we have been able to carpet and refurbish the main floor of Plant Hall. This elegant interior, which carries over to the Fletcher Lounge, sets a positive tone and helps to create a most favorable impression to those who visit this venerable old structure. We have been named to the National Register of Historic Places and are about to be named as one of the sites along the Bicentennial Trail.

Our student body is also being upgraded. More of our students are participating and playing meaningful roles in the University governance through service on important Trustee committees. Recently, we dismissed over 100 students who were academically deficient. At one time, our university earned a reputation for high grades and guaranteed retention. This is no longer the case.

Student recruiting is extremely important. Our efforts in this area become more intensive each year. Average throughput for our students is 2.9 years. This rapid turnover forces our Admissions Office to recruit more students each year. Despite the national trends towards slumping undergraduate enrollments, signs for the University of Tampa look favorable. Compared with last year's figures, applications for the fall are up by some 100. Acceptances are running 200 ahead of last year. The number of transfer students coming to the University is also increasing. Transferring is the vogue. It is essential that we stay ahead on the "balance of trade." Thus far, we are doing just that.

Another interesting figure is the number of applications from foreign students. Last year at this time, we had 25. Currently, there are 78, another positive indicator of our growing international image and reputation.

In addition to recruiting, fund raising was our other top priority for the year just ended. Tremendous progress was realized in this area. The prestigious **Minaret Society** established a national record by enrolling 122 charter members with total contributions in excess of \$320,000. The Forward Fund exceeded the one-half million dollar mark for the first time. The Parents and Alumni Associations also exceeded their fund raising goals.

Nationally, we were recognized by the Public Relations Society of America and received the coveted Silver Anvil Award in recognition for the Public Relations impact of the Inaugural Week events. Last year's winner in our class was the dedication of the LBJ Library. Needless to say, we are in good company.

Alumni support continues to grow. This year, we established new chapters in New York and Florida. Our alumni are one of our most important publics. We want to be responsive to your needs. Please let us hear from you.

Foundation proposals, currently outstanding, approach one million dollars. Recently, the Frueauff Foundation awarded the University \$100,000 for a revolving student loan fund. None of this would be possible unless the University were held in high esteem by those major foundations. Fund raising is the key to future progress. It will provide the margin of excellence and insure our thrust through the 70's and into the 80's. The University's 50th anniversary plans are already underway. We will keep you advised.



# over a million dollars in gifts!

Over a million dollars was received in gifts by the University of Tampa in the fiscal year 1972-73! Unlike any previous million dollar gift year, the \$1,060,849.30 was achieved without a capital campaign and with much less input from governmental sources.

Hightpoints of the year included the enrollment of 122 charter members of the **Minaret Society**, the university's new prestige giving club. The 122 Charter members gave a total of \$320,823.00. Also contributing heavily to the total was a \$250,000 challenge grant from the Dana Foundation for Charles A. Dana Professorships. The grant was matched in full in the record time of three months with a \$250,000 pledge from an anonymous donor to be paid next year. The annual Forward Fund, to which many **Minaret Society** gifts are directed, closed with a

record \$501,277.00 in 1972 and Forward Fund '73 is ahead of that pace at the half-way mark on June 30, 1973. The number of donors for all programs and purposes for fiscal 1972-73 totaled 1802, also a new high. On the down side, support from local, state and federal governments declined to \$65,125.00, as the Hillsborough County contribution phased out entirely and the university felt the impact of changing federal programs. Current operations received the largest dollar total — \$447,831.48. Capital gifts totaled \$200,598.50; the Endowment program received \$254,833.16 and scholarship and loan gifts reached \$158,586.90. Foundations contributed the largest single amount — \$328,110.40. Corporations were next with \$201,109.97, followed by Alumni gifts of \$186,781.10. Trustees, Fellows and

Counselors gave \$110,564.42; Friends — \$110,676.81; Government, local and federal — \$65,125.00; Students — \$28,034.36; Parents — \$13,240.75; Clubs — \$10,714.44 and Faculty and Staff — \$6,492.05.

On the following pages are the honor roll listings of the 1,802 donors who contributed in 1972-73 to the University's forward march toward recognition as a national "landmark of learning." The many good things over the past year done for students and accomplished in strengthening the learning environment would not have been possible without this dedication and generous help. To the many donors and volunteer workers who made the million dollar plus year possible, the University of Tampa expresses its gratitude and appreciation.




