You Are Eligible

In order to answer inquiries as to who is eligible to become a member of the University of Tampa Alumni Association, the following information is given.

It is not necessary to be a graduate of the University of Tampa in order to become a member of the Alumni Association. The Alumni files are set up as "Graduate" and "Non-Graduate" Alumni, which means that enrollment for one semester in a regular college credit course at the University of Tampa is all that is necessary for participation as a non-graduate member. As you can see, this opens the way for a very large membership, with a consequent strong Alumni Association. It has been estimated that a potential membership of 8000 is currently available to this Association.

The Alumni office has information cards on approximately 1500 former students, and is striving in every way possible to get further information that will increase its files. Of course you know that the easiest way for us to get this information is for you to mail in to us here at the University any change of address, change of name, or other information about yourself, and if you know of someone who could be a member, let us know that, too.
