Capstone project Overview

What is a capstone project?

It is a multilayered project that allows students to work hands on with a specific topic or career field

How is a capstone project different from a thesis paper?

Capstone projects are different from a thesis paper because they are flexible and can be turned in as different formats and not just as a paper

What are some different ways to can create my capstone?

Manual, Social Media Campaign, Performance, Communication Plan, or Autoethnography, etc.

When should you have at least one idea for your capstone project?

Start thinking of ideas for what you want your final capstone to look like

Consider different research and design methods you plan to use for your capstone research


MAPC 604 Conflict Resolution Consider different conflict situations you may face when working on your capstone and how to use different strategies when trying to solve them
